Mortuary Discounts Another OMA Member Benefit

OMA has agreements with mortuaries throughout Oregon for discounted prices for members and continues to negotiate additional contracts state-wide. OMA stores your choice of mortuary, disposition preference, and survivor contact information as a note in your member file. 
